**52nd Annual General Assembly (AGA): The WACA Africana Festival 2019
Pre-AGA Tour: Victoria Falls and Chobe National Park**

This tour is sold out so a waiting list has now been established. The organising committee of the Africa, Indian Ocean Islands and Middle East Region (AIM) is, however, negotiating with the handling partner to obtain additional rooms to accommodate more participants.

Post-AGA Tour: Kruger National Park

This tour was also sold but the organising committee has managed to add ten more spaces preferably taking five double occupancy rooms. As always, the additional spaces will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Potential Post-AGA Tour: Sun City

To try and ensure that no one will be disappointed should it not be possible to accommodate everyone on the post-AGA tour to the Kruger National Park, the organising committee of the AIM Region is proposing a post-AGA two night package to Sun City from 31 October–2 November which would include a game drive. Specific details will follow if the tour is confirmed.

Post-AGA Tour: Cape Town Following the Kruger National Park Tour

Catering to demand, the organising committee of the AIM Region and the handling partner have also prepared a customised package for those participants wishing to visit Cape Town following the post-AGA tour to the Kruger National Park. Details as follows:

Itinerary

4 November. Arrive in Cape Town with a transfer to hotel. Dinner at V&A Waterfront. Commodore Hotel, deluxe rooms.

5 November. Full Day Cape Peninsula Tour including lunch. Dinner and drumming at Gold Restaurant. Commodore Hotel, deluxe rooms.

6 November. Full Day Cape Winelands Tour including lunch and two separate wine tastings. Commodore Hotel, deluxe rooms.

7 November. Robben Island Excursion. City orientation and Table Mountain. Commodore Hotel, deluxe rooms.

8 November. Transfer to airport for departure.

Package Cost (based on ten participants)

USD 160.00 single supplement.
