### ***Latest Travel Regulations to Enter Indonesia***

You know what time it is? Yes, #ItstimeforBali! From 18 May 2022, no RT-PCR test results are required to be taken prior to departure from the country or region of origin to enter the Republic of Indonesia.

### ***Visas***
